Out of the above, AFC systems with 100 AFC Gates, 50 TOMs and 25 TVMs shall have been commissioned and operating satisfactorily against more than one contract in at least one country other than the country of manufacture or in India and proven with continuous service for a minimum period of TWO (02) years <i>and still working satisfactorily</i>	Kindly clarify here, that in this clause "Proven with continuous service for a minimum period of TWO (02) years and still working satisfactorily" refers to work from <u>1st January 2007</u> or ; any project since 2001 or any year can be considered and submitted. In other words, Do we need to consider similar size tender experience counting from 1st January 2007?	Experience from or between 1st January, 2007 and application submission deadline is considered acceptable. However any project since 2001 is unacceptable.
