ALSTOM, MMRC MOCK-UP OF MUMBAI METRO LINE 3 ROLLING STOCK

Alstom and Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation (MMRC) unveiled the life-sized mock-up of the trainset for Mumbai Metro Line 3 (Aqua Line). Speaking of this milestone, Alain Spohr, MD, Alstom India and South Asia said, "Our objective was to create an appropriate, future-proofed design that is relevant to the people,



the city and their expectations. This theme is called - Dynamic Fluidism. All technical and manufacturing parameters have been met in respect to the high interior density layout and space efficiency. MMRC awarded Alstom a contract worth Rs. 315 mn to supply 31 lightweight, fully-furnished modern passenger trainsets of 8 cars each (total 248 metro cars) for Mumbai Metro Line 3. Along with rolling stock, Alstom will also execute the power supply contract and equip Line 3 with Urbalis 400, its latest generation of CBTC signalling technology.
