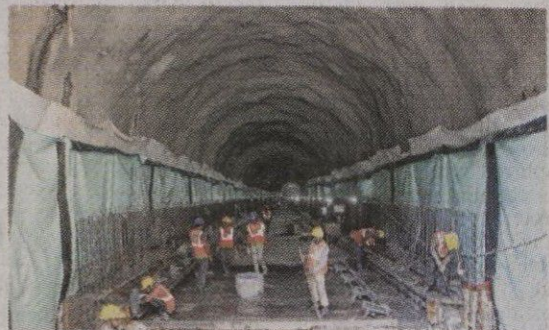
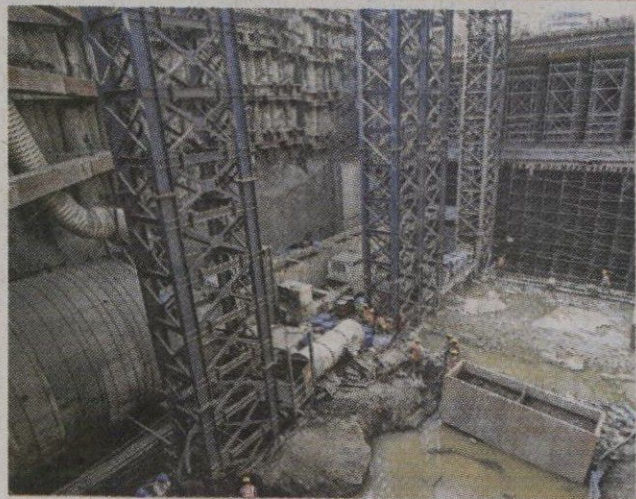
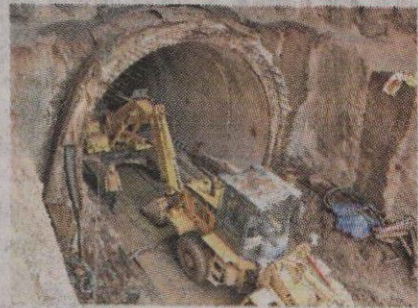


MEN AT WORK



Work on the fully underground Mumbai Metro 3 project, which will connect Colaba and SEEPZ through Bandra, is underway in full swing, with 76 per cent of the tunnelling work having been completed by the Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL) earlier this month. The MMRCL has also completed 100 per cent of its 5318 sqm concourse slab of Vidhan Bhavan station. Tunnelling of 13 of 26 proposed stations has also been done. The 17 tunnel boring machines (TBMs) deployed for the project have attained 25 breakthroughs out of a total of 32 breakthroughs.
