## First 2 cars of prototype set to arrive, trial run for Metro Line 3 could begin soon

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IN AN indication that the trial run of Mumbai Metro line-3 (Colaba-Bandra-SEEPZ) — the first underground Metro of the city — will begin soon, the first two cars of a prototype train are all set to be dispatched from Alstom trains manufacturing plant based in 5ri City, Andhra Pradesh, The move is inline with the new Maharashra government's decision to overtum the previous Uddhav Thackeray-led

MMA regime's decision to relocate the Metro 3 car shed from Aarey Colony to Kanjurmarg. Sources have confirmed that the Urban Development department has initiated proceedings to remove the stay on construction of Metro-3 car shed in Aarey. The cars of the Metro prototype trains, which were ready for nearly a year, were not brought to the city due to unavallability of the Metro car shed. They are now set to reach Mumbai within the next 8-12 days.

An official said, "It will take around 8-12 days for the trailers to arounds-12 days or me trailers to reach Mumbai and then they will be assembled at the temporary fa-cility centre (temporary Metro car shed) at Aarey. Once assembled, the trial run of the Metro can be started between Marol and Maroshi as planned. All the eight reas of the proteomer trails are cars of the prototype trains are likely to reach Mumbai around August 15 afterwhichthe testing of the Metro can be started." will be tested on various parame-ters, including speed, oscillation and emergency break distance dur-ing the 10,000-km test runs. "These ing the 10,000-km test runs. "These tests will be conducted in the turnels continencing from the temporary facility area and the trial could go on for over three-six months," the official said.

Earlier, the MMRCL had an-

nounced that the first 8-cartrain, in the form of individual coaches, will arrive in Mumbai by the end of 2021 and it will take about two 2021 and it will take about two weeks to assemble the first trainaf-ter which the trials will start. However, since work on the tem-porary facility, which started in October 2021, was delayed and there was no carshed to park the train, it was not brought to the city even after the two trains were ready.

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As per the initial plan, the first phase of MML-3 between Bandra and Seepz was planned to be completed by December 2021 and the second phase from Bandra-Kurla Complex to Colaba by June 2022. However, due to delays in the project, the MMRL is now planning to complete the first phase by January 2024 and the second in one-and-a-haffyears, provided the sissue surrounding construction of the Metro car shed is resolved. The second phase of the project from Colabato BKC is expected to be completed by mid-2025.

The Metro 3 car shed was initially proposed at Aarey Colony during the Devendra Fadravis led BJP-Shiv Sena government, Facing opposition from environmentactivists, the planor building the car shed at Aarey was crapped by Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray after the formation of Maha Vilsa Aghadi (MVA) government in November 2019 and the project was shifted to Kanjumarg.

On June 30, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and his deputy Devendra Fadravis decided in the first cabinet meeting to overtum the MVA government's decision of shiftling the car shed from Aarey. Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadravis directed officials of the Urban Development Department to bring a proposal for building the car'shed at Aarey. The mowe to shift the car'shed out of fadray had been a major bone of contention between the
