Mahalaxmi station: 40th breakthrough for MMRCL

Mumbai: The MMRCL achieved its 40th breakthrough at Mahalaxmi station on the Metro 3 corridor on Saturday.

Tunnel boring machine Tansa 1 completed its downline drive of 1135.5 m from Science Museum station to Mahalaxmi station in 325 days using 757 concrete rings.

"We have completed twin tunnels beneath western railway track between Mahalaxmi and Lower Parel stations. Also, the tunnels are in close proximity of 17 m deep MCGM underground sewer pumping station at Jacob Circle," said Ranjit Singh Deol, Managing Director of MMRCL.
