

Metro 3 completes 2km of tunnelling

Mumbai: Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation (MMRC), which is executing the Metro 3 Colaba-Seepz network, has completed over 2 kms of tunnelling. Metro3 is a 33.5 km long corridor, but 52 kms of tunnels have to be bored as there will be two tunnels—for Up and Down directions.

An MMRC spokesperson said, “We have completed a total of 2192 metres of tunnelling.” MMRC managing director Ashwini Bhide said, “It is a milestone to complete more than 2km of tunnelling in a short span.” The first tunnel boring machine started working on November 10 and, the 1 km of tunneling was completed last month.
