 Over four decades since it was first proposed, the Mumbai Trans-Harbour Link (MTHL) is set to be opened in a few weeks after 2024 sets in. The bridge is expected to drastically reduce travel time between Mumbai and Pune on the one hand and between Mumbai and the under-construction

Navi Mumbai international airport on the other

With projected savings of 1 crore litres of fuel a year and 25,680 million tons of carbon dioxide emissions, it will have a capacity to handle 50,000-60,000 vehicles

Provisions have been made for anticrash and noise barriers as well as an intelligent transport system to monitor traffic

There will be interchanges at Sewri in Mumbai, and Shivaji Nagar, Jasai and Chirle in Navi Mumbai
