PROJECT REPORT READY. AAREY TO BENEFIT TOO

A detailed project report (DPR) for the extension of the Metro 3 underground corridor up to Navy Nagar, Colaba, has been finalised by implementing authority Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation (MMRC). The extension, if approved, will help the corridor effectively gain at least four more stabling lines besides the ones coming up at eco-sensitive Aarey, It will thus help in arresting the footprint of Metro-related infrastructure at the depot during future capacity increases. DEMAND FOR THE PROJECT

➤ The Navy sought this extension as it has around 1 lakh people, including a floating population, in Navy Nagar

➤ Naval authorities felt Metro services will serve these inhabitants better as right now they have to rely on BEST buses, personal vehicles and taxis to travel in one of the most congested parts of south Mumbai The ministry of defence thus requested the state

government to operate Metro 3 services from Navy Nagar

➤ The proposal was referred to MMRC, whose board has approved the extension

RELATED BENEFITS

55 is the number of stabling lines planned for the corridor by 2050

30 is the number proposed currently

4 stabling lines at Navy
Nagar would mean that
many will not have to be
built at Aarey. It means two
trains can be parked at
Navy Nagar, apart from
Cuffe Parade, which is
currently the southern
terminus station of Metro 3

Extending Metro 3 will definitely reduce pollution as commuters from Navy Nagar will shift to Metro. It may not be of much benefit to those living in other parts of Colaba
