

FIRST SET OF 8 TRAINS FOR DRIVERLESS METRO OP ARRIVE IN BEIGE-AQUA HUES

Colourful rakes arrive in city as Metro Rail 3's driverless operations on its first phase from Aarey to BKC are expected to begin by December this year. A total of 9 trains will be required for this phase out, of which 8 have been received. With Mumbai's beaches being the central theme, the color of the rolling stock is a unique blend of comfort (beige) and freshness (aqua green) which will provide a relaxed and refreshing travel experience, said MMRC spokesperson.
