



Seven rivers in a metro

Taking a cue from other world cities, Mumbai's underground Metro Rail tunnel, which is under construction, will introduce names for each of the tunnel-boring machines that are building its first underground line. Since the construction is divided into seven packages, the tunnel boring machines have been named after seven rivers of Maharashtra. This will make them easier to identify and capture the progress of construction. The seven rivers building Mumbai's Underground Metro are Package 1: Surya, Package 2: Vaitarna, Package 3: Tansa, Package 4: Krishna, Package 5: Godavari, Package 6: Tapi and Package 7: Wainganga.
